Crops, Rates & Application:

Hydra-Hume can be applied to all crops including: Vegetable crops, row crops, field crops, trees & vines.

Foliar application: Apply 1-4 quarts per acre in enough water for thorough coverage. Can be used in most crop protection sprays.

Soil application: Apply 1/4–3 gallons per acre in soil applications.

Starter/Sidedress: Apply 1-3 gallons per acre with starter fertilizers or 1 gal/ 20 gal Uran preplant, broadcast or sidedress.
